

## **STANDING WORKING GROUP HISTORY OF LAIC EDUCATION: CONCEPTS, POLICIES AND PRACTICES AROUND THE WORLD**

### **2019 REPORT**

Created in 2016, this working group started its meetings during the ISCHE 39th Annual Conference in Buenos Aires. Since then, we have had three meetings with 41 papers presented in 12 different panels in Buenos Aires, Berlin, and Oporto. Until now, the group has welcomed colleagues from Argentina, Belgium, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Spain, France, Mexico, Peru, Portugal, Central African Republic, and Uruguay.

We aim to contribute to explain the processes and conditions that made possible the transition from religious education to secular and laic education as one of the strategies by which modern states procured hegemony and as a means of peaceful coexistence and respect for cultural and religious diversity around the world.

We have committed to organizing panels and discussions with specialists from different countries at ISCHE conferences and to then publishing a selection of the presentations in at least one book. Our goal is to deliver the book to ISCHE's correspondent committee in 2022 and to have it published by ISCHE Book Series. Following ISCHE publishing guidelines, the articles should be written in English to ensure the most extensive readership possible. It should be noted that the whole book will undergo peer-review.

To fulfil our aim of gathering the best contributions for the book, for our fourth meeting, we have decided to close our call for new contributions. Therefore, for 2020 the participants in one or more SWG previous meetings, and based on such participation, will submit an abstract through the electronic conference system. Abstracts may be written in any of the ISCHE languages and translated into English. Acceptance decisions will be communicated following the same procedures and dates for participants at ISCHE 42. Drafts of the complete articles must be sent to the coordinators of this SWG in any of the ISCHE official languages, by June 30, 2020.

Member of the SWG will read the papers. Two reviewers will be assigned to each paper and they will present their comments during the multi-session symposium at ISCHE in August 2020. A period of time will be later allocated to make any necessary revision, and then the final version of the articles will be sent to the coordinators. We expect to have the draft of the book by ISCHE 43 in Milan, where we will discuss the final versions and hold our last meeting.
