Professor (W3) for Educational Sciences with a focus on

Educational Theory

to begin as soon as possible.

Responsibilities:

The professorship will make a significant contribution to research in the domain of Educational Theory. It is expected that the successful candidate participates in the further development of one of the faculty's research profiles ("Normativität in Wissenschaft und Lebenswelt", "Erziehung und Bildung unter Bedingungen der Heterogenität", "Bildungsprozesse im Kontext von Organisationen"). Required are experiences in the acquisition of competitive third-party funding, academic self-administration and management. Teaching requirements of 9 semester hours per week have to be fulfilled, by offering courses in the teacher training program as well as other study programs at the faculty, with regard to both theoretical foundations of education and, if possible, qualitative research methodologies.

Qualifications:

The following application requirements must be documented in accordance with the Rhineland-Palatinate Higher Education Act (Hochschulgesetz, HochSchG): a completed university degree or a degree at a comparable higher-education institute (excluding Bachelor), or a master's degree, a Ph.D degree in Educational Sciences or in a related area, pedagogical aptitude as well as additional scientific achievements (§ 49 Abs. 2 HochSchG). Further requirement for Professorships in teacher-training programs is normally evidence of at least three years of experience in school practice. The appointment of the professorship is subject to the regulations of the Concordat of Rhineland-Palatinate dd. 29 April 1969. According to the final protocol to Article 1 (1), the chair should take special account of religious education.

The State of Rhineland-Palatinate and the University of Koblenz-Landau represent a concept of intensive support for students and therefore expect a high presence of lecturers at the university.

For appointments with equivalent suitability, qualifications and professional performance women are given preferential consideration, to the extent and as long as there is underrepresentation. This does not apply if there are such serious reasons in the person of an applicant that they outweigh the requirements for equality of women.

For appointments with equal qualification disabled applicants will be given preference.
